Disqualifying Factors

(Section 16.2 of the Charities Act 2005)

To qualify as an officer under the Charities Act an officer must not be:

- an undischarged bankrupt
- under the age of 16 years

• convicted of a crime involving dishonesty (section 2(1) of the Crimes Act 1961) and sentenced within the last 7 years

• prohibited from being a director or promoter of, or being concerned or taking part in the management of, an incorporated or unincorporated body under the Companies Act 1993, the Securities Act 1978, the Securities Markets Act 1988, or the Takeovers Act 1993

• disqualified by the Charities Registration Board under section 31(4) of the Charities Act 2005

• subject to a property order made under the Protection of Personal and Property Rights Act 1988, or have their property managed by a trustee corporation under section 32 of that Act (this relates to people who are not fully able to manage their affairs).

Who can be a Nominee, Nominator and Seconder?

The Nominee, Nominator and Seconder must be members of a men's shed that is a member of MENZSHED NZ and all must be within the same Region.

The Nominator and Seconder must be from separate sheds and must have the authority of the shed to sign.

The Nominee may be from the Nominator or Seconders shed, or another shed that is a member of MENZSHED NZ.

Note:

The MENZSHED NZ Constitution Rule 8.1.2 states...

... the term of office for each person elected to the National Executive shall be a period of two years.

- (a) the elections for the positions of Secretary, Treasurer, and Regional Representatives for odd numbered regions shall be held on each odd numbered year.
- (b) the elections for the positions of Chairman, Support Services, and Regional Representatives for even numbered regions shall be held on each even numbered year.

For 2020, elections are required for Regions 2, 4 and 6. (An election may be required for Region 1 if the role is still vacant.)

The Nominee may be from the Nominator or Seconders shed, or other shed (that is a member of MENZSHED NZ).

Note:

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"... the term of office for each person elected to the National Executive shall be a period of two years.

- (a) the elections for the positions of Secretary, Treasurer, and Regional Representatives for odd numbered regions shall be held on each odd numbered year.
- (b) the elections for the positions of Chairman, Support Services, and Regional Representatives for even numbered regions shall be held on each even numbered year."

For 2020, elections are required for the Chairman and the Support Services roles.
