Otaki	Otaki MenzShed has been involved in making two sets of crosses. The first was a little over 100 for the Otaki RSA which are placed at the serviceman's cemetery just before Anzac Day each year and removed soon after the Retreat. The second lot was a few hundred for Kapiti Coast District Council (KCDC) to put on display to commemorate Armistice Day.
