Earlier this year we extended the garden area and our summer crop has been very good thanks to our keen gardeners, however they could do with some assistance in keeping garden well tended, any members who are keen gardeners are welcome to join the gardening group, all surplus produce is taken to the vege stand (made by the Menzshed) at Community House.


The course is limited to 16 participants and will run from 10.00am - 2.30pm, lunch provided, there will be a Police guest speaker 1.00 - 2.15pm
